We are excited to invite you once again to participate in the Annual LAUP Fiesta in Holland, Michigan!

Attached you will find our Food Booth Application for 2010 which includes the details you need for the weekend of April 30 and May 1.

Please note that those of you who in the past were able to serve under LAUP's blanket food service license will now have to apply individually directly to City Hall for your own license. As a result, we no longer hold our annual group meeting with City Food Inspector, Rick Wyman. If you are applying to LAUP for Fiesta only, and will not be serving during Tulip Time, please contact Roberto Jara or Valentin Molina at LAUP in order to discuss arrangements before sending in your application.

Additionally, the schedule of Fiesta is changing. On Friday evening, April 30, we will be providing outdoor entertainment from 6:00 PM to 9:00 PM as in past years. However, entertainment activities on Saturday are not slated to begin until 11:00 AM (whereas, they had begun at 9:00 AM in the past) and will go until 7:00 PM (whereas they had ended at 5:00 PM in the past). We believe this will make for a more profitable Saturday for you, our vendors. As you will see from the applications, the City will still require you to be ready for inspection at 8:00 AM on Saturday and there will still be activity in the Marketplace well before 11:00 AM due to the Carnival and other activities.
